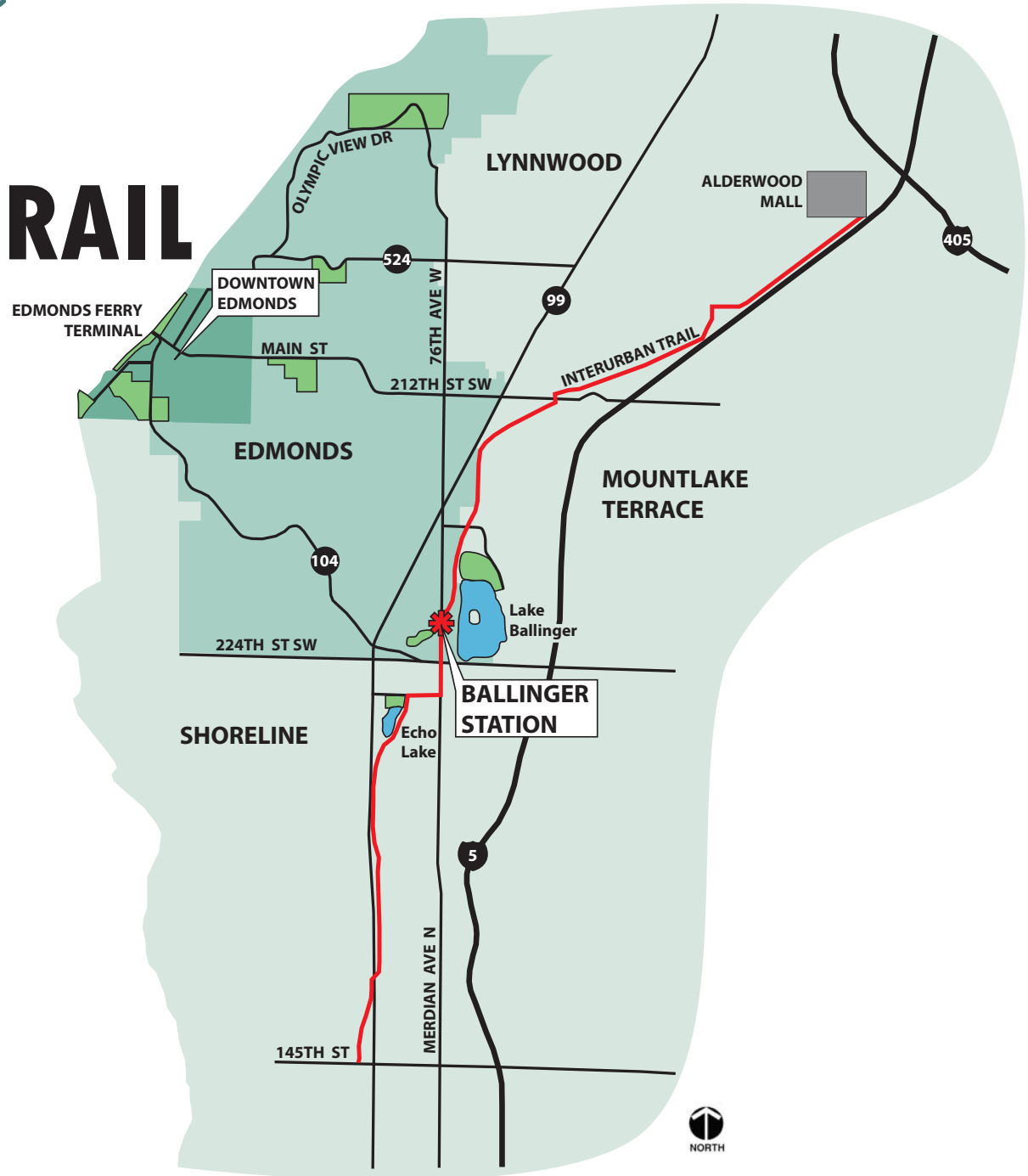


# Welcome to EDMONDS INTERURBAN TRAIL

In the late 1800's transportation of commuters and freight in south Snohomish County relied heavily on water transport and "Mosquito Fleet" steamers on Puget Sound.

With the introduction of electric interurban railways in the late 1880's all that began to change and the "Interurban" had a significant role in defining early twentieth century transportation routes and growth patterns in this region and across the county.

The former Interurban route is now a trail system which encourages non-motorized transportation in our region.
