**Proceed under bridge**

From the lake trail, turn right into parking lot, stay on road under Aurora, take first available left onto Woodland Pl. N.

Ride through Zoo Parking Lot and take underpass, under Phinney.

**Trail Begin/End**  
Total route distance from Green Lake: 10 miles  
Proceed immediately on lake
