there are still 200 people who have not re-registered in the new "lottery winners class" as of about 10am on Saturday. i'm sending this email to one person on each team who has at least one team member who has not registered -- hoping you'll reach out to your buddies and help me cat herd (it may be you)

Registration closes 09-apr at 11:59pm. you must re-register to claim your lucky lottery winning.

Everyone who was selected should have received an email from "RAMROD + imAthlete" near 5pm on 4/4 with instructions on how to register (its complicated)

dont share your invitation emails. they only work once and your token will be spent and you wont be able to register. **only** use the one from ImAthlete

FYI

from a registration perspective, teams don't matter anymore, since initial registration closed on 3/31. teams for the lottery, but now the "new" lottery is over, you all can behave as individuals without impact to the other team members. some can fail to re-register, some can cancel later. no impact on the others. and on 7/27, as always, you can ride with whomever

going forward in ImA, pretend you are now individuals. you were invite to register or placed on the WaitList as a group as defined on 4/1

also check the Wait List on the RCC site. if you are NOT on that list, you should have gotten an invitation. a few users did not correctly enter their email in the March registration, or their invitation went to "junk"

team captains may get emails about members joining or not. **ignore those too**. irrelevant collateral damage from the first lottery glitch on 4/1
