This morning the City of Renton refused me access to the ERC claiming that it was closed for the Seahawks 12K. There were no signs posted and no detour was available. Usually when trails like the Sammamish River Trail or the Burke Gilman are used for a private event they are not closed but signs are posted ahead of time warning of anticipated high usage. Why is the City allowed to close a county trail and why are they not required to provide a detour? (This is on the popular, signed, Lake Washington Loop route and during the time it took me to ride down to the dead-end and back I saw perhaps 50 other cyclists who were similarly inconvenienced. If one recreational group is going to be prioritized over another there has to be a process and an opportunity for appeal.)
